Our annual state testing for students in 3rd-5th grade will take place this spring. Third and fourth graders will take untimed tests in English-Language Arts and Math; fifth graders will take these exams, as well as a Science test. **Short-term independent study contracts will not be approved during these weeks for students in grades 3-5. Please try to avoid scheduling medical or dental appointments during school hours for this time period, as well.**

- Eating a full, healthy breakfast every morning.
- Arriving to school on time each day.

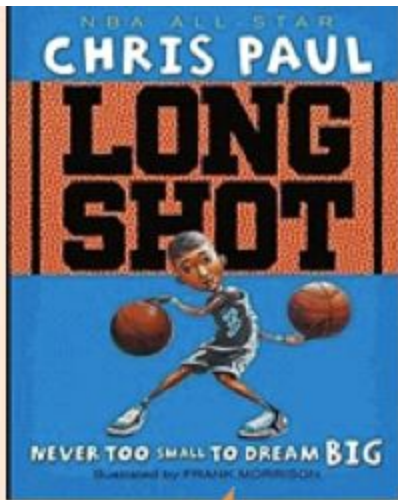
