



The 2019 Lucretia Van Horn Memorial Art Award

THEME: “We’re In It Together: how teamwork changes our lives”

PURPOSE: To honor the legacy of the gifted artist and educator Lucretia Van Horn. Lucretia worked with such noted artists as Diego Rivera, Pablo O’Higgins, and David Park. The Lucretia Van Horn Memorial Art Award was created by her grandson Van Adams (former administrator of CUSD), and his family, in order to celebrate the arts by recognizing outstanding middle school artists in the Cupertino Union School District.

First Prize: \$250 [First Prize is a “Purchase Prize” meaning that the winner’s school will keep the student’s art work, which will then be framed and displayed in the school office.]
Second Prize: \$100
Third Prize: \$50

GUIDELINES:

- This competition is open to any student attending a CUSD middle school.
- Only 1 (one) entry per student please.
- The Entry Form (located on the back side) must be written legibly and taped to the back of your artwork.
- Artwork should express your interpretation of the theme.
- Artwork should be two-dimensional only.
- Artwork can be of any media or combination of media.
- Artwork should not exceed 18” X 20”.
- Artwork must be original and completed entirely by the student.

Entries will be judged on creativity, mastery of the medium, and theme development.

Winners will be announced by no later than 5/17/19, and will be formally presented with their award at the CUSD Board of Trustees meeting on 5/23/19.
