## CUPERTINO UNION SCHOOL DISTRICT 2016-2017 ANNUAL REPORT OF DEVELOPER FEES

In accordance with Government Code Sections 66001(d) and 66006(b), the district is required to prepare an annual report of the uses of developer fees.

In 1987, the Board of Education enacted developer fees to defray the costs of providing additional classroom facilities to serve student enrollment growth resulting from new development. Effective February 2016, the fee schedule was revised to \$2.09 per square foot for residential developments, and the revised schedule for commercial development is \$.34 per square foot.

A total of \$713,098 was collected in developer fees for 2016-2017. This amount was comprised of \$710,037 paid for residential development and \$3,061 paid for commercial development. An additional \$9,689 was earned in interest income. A total of \$341,556 was expended during the year for modular classrooms at Collins, De Vargas, Dilworth, Eisenhower, Faria, Garden Gate, Lincoln, McAuliffe, Meyerholz, Montclaire, Nimitz, Regnart, Sedgwick, Stevens Creek and Stocklmeir Elementary Schools; Cupertino, Kennedy and Miller Middle Schools; and for other administrative costs.
