We will continue to work with the trainers from Teachers College. CAASPP Testing went very smoothly this year. Our students were focused and calm throughout and spent many many hours on their tests. Our 5<sup>th</sup> grade parents have received math placement results. More than half of our 5<sup>th</sup> graders were placed in the 6/7 class. Some, if not all, of our classes will be piloting a personalized online learning system next year called ScootPad. Our incoming Kindergarten parents came for an information session in mid-April. So far, we have two Kinder classes for next year but it looks like we might be gaining about a classful from Requests for Transfers. We should know for sure by Friday. As of now, we are projected one class bigger for next year and this additional group of Kinders would be another additional class! We had over 50 parents here for the parent workshop titled "How to Get your Kids to Listen." Next year we will have her come back to do a workshop on technology usage and kids. Over 100 students participated in the Science Fair! The morning enrichment class finished up and presented their Forensics unit last Friday. Applications are in for next year's groups. Open House was a success. We have Field Day tomorrow and Talent Show on Wednesday. A few of our staff members - Debbie Broeker, Betty Prokey, and Salina Snipes- will be retiring this year. Melissa Reis will be taking a leave of absence to be with her family, Marissa Allen will be teaching in the Saratoga School District next year, and Mei-Ling Chang will be moving to Dallas. We welcome some new staff members - Tambrey Snyder, Steve Greenfield, Eva Gens, and Anna Straus to our teaching staff.
