Meeting Minutes
March 4, 2019

- I. Meeting called to order at 7:50am
- II. The January meeting minutes were approved with two minor changes (a missing comma and one forgotten word at the end of a sentence)
- III. Principal's Report
 - A. All grade levels are in their fourth Reader's and Writer's Workshop units. March 20th-22nd, our 3rd- 5th grade teams will be working again with their Teacher's College trainer. The 5th graders head to Science Camp this week. When they return, they'll be taking the two performance tasks for middle school math placement. The school board is close to approving an updated middle school math course list aimed at increasing personalization and flexibility and reducing stress. Our March Learning Day will have two parts with the morning having us at another campus and teachers taking classes based on their interests- from STEAM/technology to guided reading. In the afternoon, we'll be back at Dilworth doing some curriculum and calendar planning for next year and cross-grade level conversations about reading and writing. Family Literacy Night was a HUGE success. Many families came to celebrate their love of reading and it was wonderful to see (and hear) so many students proudly sharing their writing. SoulShoppe Workshop #4 (Allyship: Empathy in Action) took place on February 11th. Adorable will be back this Friday to work with 2nd and 3rd graders on these tools. The next workshop, Be-You-Tiful is on Friday, March 15th. We had 127 open enrollment applicants!! Student Assignment messaged families from the Sedgwick neighborhood late last week notifying them they would have priority and the Open Enrollment lottery will be in late March. We've done two rounds of Kinder tours and will be offering one more round to the Open Enrollment families in a few weeks. The after-school program survey went out a few weeks ago. We received 14 responses. 85% of these want STEAM/Engineering programs after school; 71% are looking for sports. These results have already been shared with CuperDoodle for 2019-2020 DragonCare planning.
- IV. Budget
 - A. We continue to be frugal. We spent a bit more on color printing, but overall, we are good. It was discussed that the funding for site personnel should continue for next year and everyone agreed.
- V. Annual Parent Survey
 - A. We discussed the survey and noted all necessary changes. Those changes will be made. We will again offer the participation incentive for classes achieving at least an 80% participation rate.
- VI. SSC members for next year.
 - A. Two members will be leaving our site next year and they will be missed. We discussed how to recruit new members. We will publicize in the dispatch, as well as the upcoming Kinder Information Meeting.
